Meeting called to order by Clem Suchy at 7:12 - Minutes approved.

Treasurers report-Kevin went over his report. Balance on hand \$4,276.93
We lost money with the Taco in a Bag sales. Report accepted as read.

The re-draw for button winners was on August 17th, there are still 6 button winners who did not respond. If not claimed, prizes will be held over for next years drawings. Approved. **Suggestions:** Have winners sign when prize is picked up, so we will know who won what.

Farmers Market will run every Saturday morning until produce is gone. There have been 2-3 Vendors. LaNell Schlosser turned in the 5% from the sales so far.

Clem reported that Cheri Laske would make 2-4x8 permanent signs for Tornado Days for about \$500.00. He also reported that the Ram Auction sign went over \$250.00, so he didn't bid any more. Motion made and seconded to have Cheri make the signs. R.O. Luedeke will store the signs in one of his sheds.

Mid Country Pullers are set for the tractor pull (garden tractors, ATV etc) for next year. It will cost about \$350.00. They will supply the prizes or trophies.

Suggestion: Have down town Vendors pay for their spot, like the other crafters have to pay, LaNell, Marcia and others will check with vendors to see what how much they have to pay at other places.

Clem brought up the idea of possibly closing off the street from the Lumber Yard to the Fire Hall during Tornado Days, so more games and things could be offered on the street. Kevin would check with the grocery store and lumber yard if they would be ok with that.

Halloween Party 4:00-6:00 p.m. Saturday, October 29th at the Community Ctr. We will be collecting Treats for troops. There will be a box at the Grocery Store and Liquor Store for items.

Motion was made and seconded to spend \$250.00 for Halloween favors. Diane & LaNell will set up.

We will be serving hot dogs, chips, pop; juice from McDonalds (can take back what's not used)

The entrance fee will be \$1.00 a person for 1 hot dog, chips and a drink. If they would like to have another hot dog, the cost would be another \$1.00. Announcement in Independent. Approved. We need more helpers. Some of the teachers from school will help.

After much discussion, a motion was made and seconded to keep the parade announcer we have had for the last couple of years and pay him \$150.00. We can help him out with the names and have him watch his language. He does a good job and has all the equipment necessary for the parade and church service.

Kevin reported the Zoomba and Art appreciation classes at the Community Ctr . Also if anybody would want to walk during the winter months, the Center would be open. Louise brought up the possibility of holding card or bridge games at the center for a free donation. There would have to be an organizer for this.

Biscuits, Gravy & Scrambled Eggs are again set for Sunday, November 20th . 8:00 a.m. to Noon. Start frying at 7 a.m. Will purchase extra hamburger to make patties for those who don't want the biscuits. Louise Cook will pursue this endeavor.
