### **Minutes of July 16, 2009 Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 a.m. by Pastor Ken Thiele.

**Meeting minutes:** from June were reviewed and approved as submitted. Dwight and Clem motioned, Team approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** \$2,187.10 on hand. \$250 will be spent for the tent for Tornado days. \$125 was received for buttons from the Lions. Curt will be picking up the remainder of the buttons and will sell them at the event. Dwight and Clem motioned, Team approved

**Directory:** Current supply is nearly gone. Keri will contact Patti and will send the next copy to printer. We are committed to (not paid for) 500 additional copies. Ken introduced us to Productive Alternatives (getting young disabled adults work). We cannot get it in to the directory at this time, but will immediately put on the Web site. Dianne and Clem motioned that we do not charge them for future advertisement; team approved.

**Throws / Blankets:** 60 throws have been received / 30 are on order. \$700 has already been sold. \$1,700 in expenses for the throws (\$1,140 for 1<sup>st</sup> processing, \$570 for the 2<sup>nd</sup>). A table will be set up at the Crafters Sale and at Gwens to be sold over the Tornado Days weekend. Dwight and Keri motioned, team approved that one will be given as a door prize from button sales.

**Button Sales:** There are about 75 buttons left to sell. Curt and others have several new door prizes. The drawing will be at noon on Sunday; prizes to be picked up at Miltona Grocery. There will be \$100, \$50, \$30, \$20 cash drawings in addition. The numbers will be posted on the web site for one month. If prizes are not claimed, new numbers will be drawn.

**Habitat for Humanity:** school presentation done, waiting for any approved people.

**Calendar for Miltona Events:** contact Patti for any events.

**Community Center sign:** still in the process of looking. A temporary sign from the Lions can be used at other times.

**Chamber of Commerce / Advertisement:** a line item will be in the Friday letter.

**Breakfast Fund Raiser:** tabled until August meeting. Gen is getting costs for sausage gravy and biscuits.

**Tornado Days:** Radio Advertisement is still incorrect (stating Don Shelby is in the parade). Keri will be calling for the 4<sup>th</sup> time to get this corrected; she will now refuse to pay for the ads.

Community Bake Sale: Thrivent; they will match funds raised (\$1 for every \$4 raised). Proceeds will go to MCC. Coordinators are still looking for help.

Parade: Skip Timmins is coordinating. He will arrange for a microphone by the Shelter. Line up: Color Guard, Fire trucks, Grand Marshall's (Oldest Man and Oldest Women) is tentative.

Help is needed for cleaning up after all events on Sunday; about 1 – 1:30. Spruce Center 4H is helping.
