### Minutes of December 18, 2008 Meeting

#### IN ATTENDANCE

President Clem Suchy called the meeting to order and welcomed Pete Watt, sales and marketing director for the Alexandria Blizzard hockey team; Dave Dirks, park manager at Carlos State Park; and Shelly Wevely, naturalist at the Miltona Elementary Science Magnet School.

#### MINUTES

Dwight moved, Dianne seconded, to accept the minutes of November 20, 2008 as submitted. Carried.

#### FINANCIALS

Kevin reported that as of 12/17/08, the cash on hand for Team Miltona was \$2,604.63, and a negative balance for the Miltona Commercial Club of -\$212.69, for a combined balance on 12/17/08 of \$2391.94. Ken moved, Dwight seconded, to approve the report as submitted. Carried.

#### OLD BUSINESS

##### Lite'n Up Miltona

Dwight reported that the event was a success. The consensus was that the event should again be held in 2009.

The following recommendations were suggested:

Advertising between Team Miltona and the Miltona Fire Dept. should be better coordinated, and that information should be sent to the Miltona Elementary School in a timely manner to be included in the weekly school newsletter sent to the parents.

2 burning barrels, rather than 3, should be sufficient

The same number of transportation drivers would be needed.

More caroling groups (besides the group from Rose City Free Church) should be enlisted.

The city's street decorations should not be turned on until the day of the event.

Additional street decorations are needed. The consensus was that new decorations should be purchased rather than seeking donations of used decorations from other municipalities.

Planning for the 2009 Lite'n Up Miltona event should be tabled for a few months.

##### Pancake Breakfast—January 11, 2009

Dick, Kevin, and Clem did a "dry-run" of the breakfast for Team Miltona members prior to the meeting, with help from Sharon Kuehn. The consensus was that the pancake breakfast would be a success.

Dick reported that all breakfast necessities have been purchased or ordered.

The charge for the breakfast is \$5.50; no charge for children under 5 years of age.

Additional sausages are \$.50.

A worker sign-up sheet was passed around. Dick and Sharon will coordinate the workers. Lisa will see if kids from the Miltona School would like to help. Clem will be in charge of getting all signs and posters distributed. A poster will also be put up at Carlos State Park. Kerry will provide all other advertising for Dick. Set-up for the breakfast will be Jan. 10 at 1:00 p.m. Ken and Kerry will bring additional grills for the breakfast.

#### Directory

Kerry reported that the directories will be available for distribution at the Team Miltona sponsored pancake breakfast on Jan. 11.

#### Habitat for Humanity

Ken suggested that Team Miltona place another newspaper ad soliciting applicants for a H for H home in Miltona. He will contact the Alex H for H to see if aid is available in paying for the ad.

#### Lighted Sign for Comm. Ctr.

#### Personalized Blankets/Throws

Kerry will have placemats made for the pancake breakfast, showing what the blankets would look like. She will also have a “pre-order” sign-up sheet available to gauge interest in the blankets before Team Miltona commits to an order.
